## 2017 LANDCARE ART PRIZE

### LANDCARE ASSOCIATION OF SA

The Landcare Association of SA aims to contribute to improving sustainable production and natural resources management by forming and activating resilient Landcare Groups and networks within South Australia.

We achieve this by forming partnerships and collaborations with stakeholders in natural resources management, engaging with the wider Landcare and NRM movement at Regional and State levels, and Nationally. As the peak Landcare body in South Australia, sitting on the National Landcare Network Board and Members Council; and, connecting Landcare activities and programs across South Australia to enhance communication and learning.

### 2017 LANDCARE ART PRIZES

The announcement of prize winners will be made at the SA Landcare Conference Dinner and Landcare Awards night at the Clare Country Club, White Hut Road, Clare, on Tuesday, 12<sup>th</sup> September, 2017, with announcement in the local media and on the Landcare Association of SA Facebook page and website to follow.

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entry is open to all Artists residing in South Australia to submit artwork that symbolizes the theme ***'Celebrating Innovation and Diversity in Landcare - What Landcare means to me.'***

Competition entries are free. Applications open on Monday, 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2017, and close on Friday, 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2017 at 5.00pm.

Artwork is to be delivered by Friday, 1st September, 2017. Delivery address to be notified with confirmation of application.

The competition comprises of four categories with each category awarding First and Runner-up Prizes, and 3 Primary School categories, with the Judges awarding a Certificate of Commendation for further artworks of outstanding calibre symbolizing the theme ***'Celebrating Innovation and Diversity in Landcare - What Landcare means to me.'***

All artwork will be viewed by a Judging Panel with the Judging Panel's decisions being final. No correspondence will be entered into regarding Judging Panel decisions.

Selected artwork will be invited to be displayed at the 2017 State Landcare Conference.

Artists may enter in only one Art Award category for which they qualify for and have written proof of verification if need be.

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY (cont.)

A limit of 3 pieces of artwork per Artist.

Entrants may not enter under a different name or using false information.

All entries must be original work of the entrant and not copied from any existing artwork or design, and completed within the last 2 years.





## 2017 LANDCARE ART PRIZE

Artwork must not contain content that is offensive or discriminatory.

Entries can be two dimensional or three dimensional artworks in any medium, including photography and video clips.

All two dimensional artwork is to be ready to hang. Any artwork not ready for hanging will not be placed on show.

Stretched canvases are considered framed.

All artwork is to have the Artist name, title of artwork, and contact details on the back top right hand corner.

All artwork must accompany a copy of the Entry Form with a brief Artist Statement (a maximum of 100 words), describing how the artwork relates to the theme.

Once an entry is submitted, it cannot be amended or replaced.
